PATIENCE DRIVE raced four then three wide on the first turn, was reserved at the back of the compact field, went three then four wide on the far turn, was asked in the vicinity of the quarter-pole, rallied under strong urging, closed well to get the lead inside the furlong marker then drew clear under strong hand urging. UPPERLINE was rated on the inside, moved up to contest the lead with five furlongs to run, inched clear approaching the five-sixteenths pole, was set down in upper stretch, lost the lead inside the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while well clear for the place. CAVE CREEKER was away awkwardly, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled just off the pace, saved ground on the far turn, came off the inside and was roused at the top of the stretch and proved no match for the top two while able to get the show. MIDWAY HOLIDAY raced four then three wide on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped out in upper stretch and tired. THE RUMOR'S TRUE raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace, dropped back while off the rail on the far turn and gave way.
