Footnotes

TONTO TOO contested the pace on the inside of OLLIE BABY, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when put to the whip in upper stretch and edged clear in the final furlong under strong urging. OLLIE BABY raced two to three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn, was asked in upper stretch, battled with TONTO TOO past the eighth-pole, drifted out in the final furlong and weakened while clear for the place. PORTO BERMUDA lingered towards the rear of the field, came under some urging while near the inside on the far turn, moved out inside the quarter-pole and was along for the show. NO LIP raced three wide on the first turn, was well placed behind the leaders, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. POWERED BY STEWIE raced inside on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and failed to threaten. STEELY RAN raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. PUTITONWAYNESTAB was taken back after the start then reserved on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn and faded. LIONDRIVE raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and faltered.
