FRIENDLY BANTER raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn, dropped to three wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside the furlong marker and drew clear under strong urging. TEXAS CITIZEN set the pace, was asked at the quarter-pole, lost the lead outside the furlong marker and proved no match while able to hold the place. ONLY BOY settled off the pace, saved ground while urged along on the far turn and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. VIGILANTE LAW raced three wide on the first turn, settled behind the leader, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. ADIRONDACK EXPRESS was reserved towards the rear, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. CANDIANO raced five then four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, advanced five wide on the far turn, dropped to four wide into the

stretch and came up empty. DEED IT IS was hustled from the start, raced three then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. GOLDEN HUSKER settled towards the rear while saving ground, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, came out and bumped twice with TATER DOWNS at the top of the stretch and was no factor. HARD CASE was rated just off the pace, chased on the far turn and gave way. BIG TOWN raced three wide on the first turn and failed to respond. TATER DOWNS raced four wide into the first turn then dropped in, lagged at the rear of the field, went four wide on the far turn, bumped twice with GOLDEN HUSKER at the top of the stretch and never reached contention.
