TALEITLIKEITAIN'T widest to the turn, came four wide around the turn, rallied mid track and proved clearly best. MOON TERROR inside to the drive, eased out a bit in the lane, was steered out just after while making a late gain. YELLOW MEADOW stalked OL' JACK MAGIC from early on, bid outside that one turning for home, gained the edge and then saved the show. OL' JACK MAGIC set the pace to the drive, got collared and then faltered late. INVISIBLE FORCE well back to before the drive, circled foes and improved position. TIGER STRIKE devoid speed, was no real threat. LUCKY TRADITION forwardly placed three wide to the drive, gave way. STORM ENGINE settled inside early and was outrun. ELUSIVE MAN forwardly placed off the rail, retreated. EL MATADOR showed little.
