FAST ALEX reserved inside, continued inside to rally, got through and prevailed. ELKHORN CREEK came in at the break brushing ST LIAMS HALO, stalked that one from early on, bid nearing the drive, gained the edge, then while no match for the winner, held second. BERBERIS three wide around both turns, ranged up nearing mid stretch and then failed to sustain his bid. ST LIAMS HALO brushed at the break, was straightened quickly to set the pace to the drive, was overtaken and then weakened. MINE TRAIN unhurried, rallied wide and hung. SHELLOWEE well back, was no real threat. SOUTHERN LEGEND forwardly placed off the rail, faded. CARSON CONNECTION lunged at the break and was not a threat. CARPENTER BOB checked around the first turn and then retreated.
