

BERBERIS three wide around both turns, ranged up nearing mid stretch and then failed to sustain his bid. ST LIAMS HALO brushed at the break, was straightened quickly to set the pace to the drive, was overtaken and then weakened. MINE TRAIN unhurried, rallied wide and hung. SHELTOWEE well back, was no real threat. SOUTHERN LEGEND forwardly placed off the rail, faded. CARSON CONNECTION lunged at the break and was not a threat. CARPENTER BOB checked around the first turn and then retreated.
