JET RAIDER was urged along while just off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, was asked for his best in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up late. SPEED MONSTER was urged along on the outside, chased four then three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. BADGER BRET was urged along while just off the pace, raced three then four wide on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, closed well into the final sixteenth but also missed. RICH ELM chased the pace on the outside, engaged the leader on the turn, dueled in the stretch then was outfinished late and just missed the minor awards. JOHN'S BROWN BEAR was urged along while off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn, steadied when WHISKEY BENT broke down near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied on the far outside and closed well but missed the minor awards. GREENHOUSE BANKER was well placed on the inside, saved ground on the turn and lacked the needed response. BAILOUT KID set the pace, vied inside on the turn and gave way. BRAZILIONAIRE raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. TRUE EMOTION was in tight after the start, dropped well behind the field, raced two to three wide on the turn and was no factor. AFRICAN STORM lacked early speed, dropped to the inside on the turn and failed to respond. WHISKEY BENT was urged along while off the pace, broke down near the five-sixteenths pole and was vanned off. Following a stewards' inquiry into the incident near the five-sixteenths pole, no change was made to the order of finish.
