SMARTY GRAS showed good natural speed and quickly moved clear, set the pace while under restraint, was asked at the top of the stretch, extended the advantage into the final furlong then was fully extended to last under strong urging. HOT PURSUIT broke outward at the start, settled on the outside, came under some urging while four wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong, drifted out a bit near the sixteenth-pole and closed fast to just miss. NICE GUY was reserved off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, was asked near the three-eighths pole, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong, was taken in hand when he had his path taken near the sixteenth-pole and secured the show. EASY TO PLEASE ME was well placed just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came a bit off the rail and was asked at the top of the stretch and weakened. PULPIT'S SECRET brushed with a rival at the start, settled on the inside, was urged along while saving ground on the turn and failed to rally. DR. HUDSON brushed with a rival at the start, settled at the back of the field, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and also failed to rally. FOREST RUN tracked the pace, raced three then two wide on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, chased into the stretch and tired. ZEB settled on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the turn and failed to respond. METAIRIE settled towards the rear of the field, was urged along while three wide on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. Following a stewards' inquiry, HOT PURSUIT was disqualified from second and placed third for interference near the sixteenth-pole.
