CANON MAN was hustled to the lead and set the pace, dictated terms while off the rail on the turn, extended the lead without being encouraged in upper stretch, was flagged with the whip passing the furlong marker and proved much the best while ridden out. TACKY ANGEL was urged along at the back of the field, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the place. HEAVENVILLE was urged along on the inside of MR. PORTER, steadied and lost position early on the turn, raced three to four wide on the turn and narrowly earned the show. MR. PORTER settled on the outside, lost position early on the turn, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to rally. MR. SKIE'S SPIRIT brushed with a rival at the start, tracked the leader, raced three wide on the turn, was asked near the quarter-pole and came up empty. ROLL ME AWAY moved up to race just behind the leader, saved ground on the turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and also came up empty. SALTY SID brushed with a rival at the start, settled near the back of the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. XPECTTOOWIN ducked in sharply at the start and unseated the rider. Following a stewards' inquiry into the start, no change was made to the order of finish.
