FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. No Nomination Fee. \$350 to enter; \$400 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$75,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner; 20% to second; 11% to third; 6% to fourth; 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$45,000 on the turf since December 7, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 on the turf since then, 4 lbs.; \$25,000 on the turf since November 7, 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and starter races not considered in estimating allowances) Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. NOTE: This Stake will be limited to 14 starters should race not be split. High Weights will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Failure to draw into the race will cancel all fees. **THE OWNER OF THE WINNER TO RECEIVE A TROPHY.** Closed Saturday, January 24, 2009, with 14 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at 5 and 1/2 Furlongs.)

CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE set the pace off the rail, was headed between calls by ROUSE THE CAT approaching the drive, surged clear a furlong out, then proved best while kept to the task. GRAND TRAVERSE settled inside early, remained inside for the drive, eased out and got up for second. STORM TREASURE well back to the drive, swung out to rally, closed willingly and got up to finish on equal terms with ROUSE THE CAT for the show. ROUSE THE CAT inside CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE down the backstretch, bid around the turn, held the lead between calls nearing the drive, weakened when headed and lasted to finish on equal terms with STORM TREASURE for the show. JOHN'S ROAD raced wide to the drive, then closed mildly. ACTING ZIPPY forwardly placed three wide, weakened.
