EASY FROM THE GATE raced inside on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while off the inside on the far turn, rallied along the rail in upper stretch, squeezed through on the inside of VIBRANT SAINT passing the furlong marker, took over the lead shortly thereafter then drew clear and was eased up late. CHIEF WARRANT FIVE raced five then four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, advanced four wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and proved no match for the winner while just able to get the place. VIBRANT SAINT was reserved off the pace, shifted in leaving the backstretch, advanced inside while under urging on the far turn, made a rail bid at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong, proved no match for the winner and just missed the place. A MILLION FIELDS raced four wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was urged

along while two then three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted out in upper stretch and improved position. STORM TAMER raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, chased three wide on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch but weakened. DAKOTA COMET raced three wide on the first turn, settled well back in the field, was urged along while three then two wide on the far turn and failed to rally. JACE'S ACE was in a bit tight at the start, raced near the inside on the first turn, settled towards the back of the field, moved closer with a half-mile to run, advanced while off the rail on the far turn, shifted four wide while behind rivals outside the quarter-pole, shifted six wide at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive and came up empty. PINK TIP raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, chased while off the rail on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch then capitulated. SIR MAXWELL raced three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, advanced five wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch, was taken up while tiring near the three-sixteenths pole and faded. REDREDRED threw his head a bit at the start, raced six wide early on the first turn then dropped to four wide, took the lead entering the backstretch, moved well clear, raced inside while under urging on the far turn, was swallowed up at the top of the stretch and stopped. PLEASANT WOODMAN raced six wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while five to six wide on the far turn, drifted seven wide into the stretch and retreated. FALYN'S STAR settled on the inside, was through after a half-mile and faltered then was pulled in the stretch but walked off.
