TEN KAY saved ground while close up, bid inside AS GREAT AS SHE IS nearing the furlong marker and out finished that one to the wire. AS GREAT AS SHE IS set the pace, responded when collared and gave way grudgingly. WINTER RUN saved ground and closed late. SHAWANNA WANNA saved ground while unhurried, eased out in upper stretch and closed mildly. JUNE IN GREEN BAY allowed to settle, improved position. CYPRESS GROVES reserved early, rallied six wide and improved position. COME ON BERTIE stalked AS GREAT AS SHE IS from early on, then faded after reaching the furlong marker. ROYAL BANDITA prominent four wide, gave way. DYNA FORE ME back early, rallied seven wide and had no rally. CARRY'S LEGACY gave way after six furlongs.
