THE LAST WAVE vied outside MISTER CHES early, prompted three wide midway down the backstretch, gained the edge entering the drive, shook clear and then proved best while kept to the task. BISHOP CASEY angled in early, settled off the rail in the run down the backstretch, moved up four wide around the second turn, continued out and got up for second. ADDICTED BAY inside to the drive, was angled out turning for home, closed willingly but missed second. STREATERVILLE forwardly placed from along the inside, bid midway down the backstretch, gained the edge, responded when headed around the second turn and then weakened late. LONE STAR BREW raced wide. GUSTO NUEVO was always outrun. MISTER CHES showed speed to approaching the drive and then stopped abruptly.
