Footnotes

BANJAMMER went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, ranged up while four wide on the far turn, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole, edged clear in upper stretch and held well under steady urging. GOVERNOR'S BADGE was rated just off the pace while off the inside, drafted behind three opponents on the far turn, shifted four wide and was asked at the quarter-pole, chased under a drive in upper stretch and finished willingly while second best. WAJIR ON ME lagged at the rear of the field, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out some in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. UNO MAS settled on the inside, was urged along while continuing to save ground on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. MAJOR PRINCE was hustled from the start, went to the front, set the pace under a snug hold while off the rail, was given some free rein on the far turn, lost the lead at the quarter-pole and gave way. U HUSH went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, lost touch with the winner in upper stretch and tired. SENOR PELIGROSO went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
