KAMA devoid speed, made a run three wide around the second turn and was along for second. EXTENDED VIEW sprinted clear quickly, was headed in upper stretch and faded. DIXIE BUST trailed and then improved position. WINNING GLORY saved ground and faded. JAZZ QUEEN between foes early, was outrun. BLUSHPASSER three wide early, tired. CI CI ME four wide early, dropped back.
