Footnotes

SILENT PIPE moved clear early and remained clear throughout. DESSY inside to the drive, eased out while rallying and then held second. WING A DING crossed to the inside early, was restrained down the backstretch, came four wide around the second turn and then could make little impact. GOOD FIGHT bumped from both sides at the start, raced three wide around both turns and had no late kick. WITH ATTITUDE came in leaving the gate, then got brushed from both sides, raced three wide around the first turn and was outrun. AGUILA DE GUERRA veered out at the break bumping GOOD FIGHT, was straightened to stalk SILENT PIPE to before the drive, then gave way. MARDI GRAS KING came in leaving the gate, steadied just after, trailed and was outrun. STORM EXPERT was no real threat.
