Footnotes

FAST WOLF chased the pace on the outside, made a bid while three to four wide on the turn, inched clear in upper stretch, extended the margin inside the furlong marker and proved much the best while erratic late. BUNKHOUSE was urged along while just off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, moved out outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place. OUTRIGHT VENTURE was hard ridden while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and finished willingly but just missed the place. MOUSKOURI dropped back after the start, fell well behind, moved out in upper stretch and reached his best stride too late. ZEN TO WIN was hustled from the start, pressed the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the turn, battled past the three-sixteenths pole and tired. SOME GOLDEN CHARM was hustled from the start, set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. REEDOTHEMOSQUITOE showed speed then chased the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced inside early on the turn then came a bit off the rail and weakened. RAISE A BULLET hesitated at the start then veered out, spotted the field several lengths, dropped well behind and was distanced.
