### Footnotes

LATCH LIGHTING close up early, was restrained off the leaders before the turn, eased out around the turn, bid three wide for the drive and proved clearly best. COURAGEOUS WARRIOR settled inside early, angled out turning for home, loomed a threat and then held second. DOUBLE YOUR BID devoid speed, closed late. LA BALA out footed early, moved to the inside going to the turn, eased out in the drive but lacked the needed rally. MAGIC LAW was outrun. T Z TOP vied for the lead to before mid stretch and then weakened. DOLLAR RUN showed early foot and then faded. SATIN'S ACE showed speed to the drive and then faltered. AVERY ISLAND CAT dropped back. HOOFY hesitated at the start and was always back.
