Footnotes

SCAT ABOUT was eager while under a strong hold early then rated just off the pace, waited behind horses on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, dove to the inside after straightening for the drive, squeezed through inside of BOLD FRONT passing the furlong marker and closed wide to get up at the wire. REASON TO BE PROUD went four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, came under a drive, dueled with AT THE PULPIT into the final sixteenth, got the best of that rival but was denied at the wire. AT THE PULPIT went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace, made a bid between rivals on the far turn, was asked passing the three-sixteenths pole, dueled with REASON TO BE PROUD into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to get the show. BOLD FRONT broke through the gate prior to the start, set the pace through solid fractions, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, vied into final furlong then weakened. SOUL SACRIFICE went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, shifted four wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and lacked the needed kick. CLASS PRESIDENT bumped with FIVE AFLEET at the start, was bumped in the hindquarters by MERV early on the first turn, settled off the pace, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to rally. FIVE AFLEET bumped with CLASS PRESIDENT at the start, went four then three wide on the first turn, lingered at the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. MERV bumped with CLASS PRESIDENT early on the first turn, settled towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and failed to respond. THWART was reserved while inside on the first turn, settled on the backstretch and retreated.
