GHOST IS CLEAR was off about two lengths slow, settled at the rear, went four then three wide on the turn, angled out under a drive in upper stretch and closed very strongly to get up late. TIBAN moved up after the start, stalked the pacesetter on the outside, engaged that rival while three wide on the turn, edged clear in upper stretch, was asked near the furlong marker, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was caught. GRAND TRAVERSE settled on the outside, moved closer while four wide on the turn, chased under a drive in upper stretch and weakened while clear for the show. BARRACUDA BAY was coaxed along while off the pace, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, moved out in upper stretch and failed to rally. SANTO GATO was sent hard from the start, set the pace, vied inside on the turn and gave way. KINGSFORD DRIVE broke out at the start, was rated just off the pace, raced off the rail while under urging on the turn and came up empty. MEZCAL VIBE was urged along towards the rear, went three then four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
