BRANDI WITH AN I vied for the early lead, shook free around the turn and could not last. BRITTSKER never far back, eased out three wide for the drive and lacked the needed late kick. I KAN DO four wide early, rallied before the drive and faded. SUMMERHILL GAL closed mildly mid track. ICE GARDEN saved ground and was outrun. PREMIER TEMPEST was never a threat. ORGULLO DEL SUR never far back, had no rally. TRIPLE raced wide and was outrun. LADY BUCK showed little. CASHINON BERTIE showed speed and faltered after three furlongs. EASTERN WISH dwelt at the start and was far back.
