Footnotes

I TAKE DIAMONDS raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled at the back of the field, moved in near the half-mile pole, was urged along while inside on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, rallied along the rail in the final furlong and closed well to get up late. KARMA DISTRACTION raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, moved closer while four wide and urged along on the far turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch, closed well to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole but was outfinished late while able to get the place. PLEASANT CHIEF raced inside on the first turn, shied from a shadow early on the backstretch, set the pace through moderate fractions, vied inside on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and was also outfinished but secured the show. POPLARSAINTE settled on the inside, came off the rail midway through the far turn, was put to a drive while in striking range in upper stretch, moved out outside the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. CLASS CLOWN raced four then three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while four then three wide on the far turn, was put to a right-handed whip inside the quarter-pole, switched to a left-handed whip passing the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and weakened. GREAT PLANET raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. BAMA PARKWAY prompted the leader on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
