LAKE VICTOR chased the pace on the outside, came under stronger urging while three wide on the turn, gained ground in upper stretch, took the lead passing the furlong marker and prevailed under strong urging. ADENA'S CHANCE settled while under some urging, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well but missed. HERO OF ORDER contested the pace on the outside, vied two to three wide on the turn, had the rider lose his whip inside the three-sixteenths pole, battled determinedly under hand urging in the final furlong but also missed while clear for the show. TRAIN HEIST settled off the pace, was roused while four wide on the turn and failed to rally. ALERT WARRIOR disputed the pace on the inside, came under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. M ONE settled at the rear while under some urging, went two then three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide outside the quarter-pole and also failed to rally.
