JOYFUL VICTORY was rated while inside on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, inched closer while three wide on the far turn, drew even with the leader in upper stretch, dueled with RAVI'S SONG in the final furlong and prevailed under good handling. RAVI'S SONG raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced three wide on the far turn, made a bid while under a drive in upper stretch, dueled with JOYFUL VICTORY in the final furlong and missed. JUANITA was well rated while setting the pace on the inside, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled into the final furlong and tired while able to hold the show. DISTORTED LOVE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. FIGHTER WING raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, dropped back while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. SEEKING SHEBA raced three to four wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, dropped to the inside on the far turn and showed little. STREET STORM tracked the pace on the outside, inched closer midway down the backstretch, dropped back on the far turn and stopped.
