TOP RADIO STAR devoid speed, swung out for the drive, got steered in to rally, split foes inside the final sixteenth and prevailed. FAST FASHION between foes early, bid inside the final furlong and then was outfinished. BRAYS ISLAND settled inside to the drive, moved out to rally but was outfinished. OCEAN RIPPLE stalked the leaders three wide, took over a furlong out and then faltered late. M LEE settled off the rail, loomed four wide for the drive and then flattened out. DREW LIL SLEW devoid speed, moved up turning for home, lacked room inside the final furlong, was eased out and then hung. BURN A SPARK showed speed to the drive and then stopped. WELL HEAVENS SAKE also showed speed to the drive and then gave way.
