WHO LET THE CAT IN clear early, repulsed a bid from RIGHT PLACE N TIME a furlong out, then proved best while kept to the task. RIGHT PLACE N TIME faded while up close, loomed outside WHO LET THE CAT nearing mid stretch, then was no match for that one late. SEVENTY TWO RENO raced inside and got up for the show. HOUSE ARREST stalked WHO LET THE CAT IN to the turn, got out footed and then came again. NEVILL'S MISTAKE forwardly placed off the rail, loomed nearing the drive, then faltered. SOUP R MARKET was outrun. LANDON raced inside to no avail. BRANDON'S MARFA was always outrun. CAP IT trailed to the drive and was not a factor. FIRST BOY showed little.
