ROCKET KING bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, chased the leaders on the outside, made a bid while three wide on the turn, inched clear when asked for more in upper stretch and drew away under steady handling. ROSS LAD broke two to three lengths slow, raced well back in the field, moved out on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, was guided out near the three-sixteenths pole and got up for the place. SMARTASAWHIP bumped with rivals at the start, contested the pace on the outside of WILDCAT'S TUNE, vied off the rail on the turn, battled with ROCKET KING into upper stretch then weakened and was caught for the place. HARRIE was ridden along while well off the pace, raced three wide early on the turn, shifted five wide nearing the five-sixteenths pole, continued five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response then missed the show. ROAD RAGE ATTITUDE was bumped on both sides at the start, raced up close to the pace, steadied and lost position early on the turn, moved out and regained momentum, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, battled for the minor awards in the final furlong and missed those positions. LAURENT DU VAR reared at the start and was off two lengths slow, moved in while off the pace, raced inside early on the turn, came off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. BRYANT'S MOMENT settled just off the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, was put to an all out drive in upper stretch and tired. MONTY LIGHTNING was recalcitrant behind the gate, unseated the rider and was reluctant to load, bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and came up empty. JANIE'S CHAMP was fractious behind the gate and reluctant to load, lacked early speed, raced four wide on the turn and was no

factor. GRACE'SSONG dropped back while urged along, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. WILDCAT'S TUNE was reluctant to load, broke out and bumped with a rival, contested the pace on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn and faded.
