ICE CLIMBER settled towards the back of the field, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to get up at the wire. DR. ALEX bumped with a rival after the start, raced two to three wide on the first turn, was unhurried at the back of the field, went three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed strongly to just miss. CARSON'S HONOR was well rated while setting the pace through tepid fractions, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, was put to a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, extended the advantage into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was denied at the wire in a three-way photo. DUVEEN brushed with a rival after the start, raced three then two wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, raced three then two wide on the far turn, was asked coming to the quarter-pole, chased the leader into the final furlong, drifted out near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick. SLICK WHEELIE bumped with a rival after the start then brushed with DUVEEN, raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled in third while in hand, raced off the rail on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed response. APPROVEDBYTHEMINT moved in before the first turn, settled on the inside, came under urging while continuing to save ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. CRESTED (GB) settled in the middle of the field, was roused on the final turn and failed to respond. (Rail at 20 Feet)
