STORM HALF brushed with KAREN'S CHOICE after the start, bumped with FRIGID KISS in the early going, was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch, rallied into the final furlong and closed well to get up late. KAREN'S CHOICE brushed with STORM HALF after the start, disputed the pace on the inside, inched clear at the top of the stretch, extended the advantage when set down near the three-sixteenths pole,

held a clear lead into the final sixteenth but was caught. RAGIN RENO was well placed just off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. NO RULES NOW was hard ridden towards the front, raced four wide on the turn and also lacked the needed kick. BOUND FOR GLORY settled well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and improved position. RUNNINGFORTHEGOLD settled well back in the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. FRIGID KISS bumped with rivals in the early going, was urged along while off the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. MORGAN THE MIGHTY was urged along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. ELI'S GOLD charged the front of the gate and broke through just prior to the start, was held by the assistant starter and came out well behind the field, raced off the rail on the turn and never reached contention then was declared a non-starter. PAID UP disputed the pace on the outside, vied into the stretch and tired. THUNDER CHOP bumped with FRIGID KISS in the early going, moved to the outside, was urged along while five wide on the turn and failed to respond. Following a stewards' inquiry, ELI'S GOLD was declared a non-starter.
