ALMIRA FAWN went three wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, took the lead midway through the far turn, edged clear passing the five-sixteenths pole, responded well when asked for her best in upper stretch and drew away while drifting out late. MALIBU HOLIDAY settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and was second best. OCEAN BERTIE settled towards the rear, went two then three wide early on the far turn, shifted four wide outside the quarter-pole, advanced into upper stretch, chased the winner and weakened while able to get the show. HOLIDAY BROAD went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, went three to four wide early on the far turn, angled in near the five-sixteenths pole then advanced, shifted three wide at the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and came up empty. WILD PANTERA went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and tired. AVA AGAIN set the pace through sensible fractions, lost the lead midway through the far turn and gave way.
