Footnotes

A. P. ANSWER unhurried while outrun, split foes approaching the drive, rallied mid track in the lane, got clear and then proved best while kept to the task. CATCH THE LUCK reserved early, moved up for the drive, closed willingly but could not overtake the top one. LEMON DROP MAGIC reserved off MORAL FIBER, bid outside that one before the second turn, gained the lead between calls turning for home and while no match for the top two saved the show. MORAL FIBER set the pace from early on, was overtaken entering the drive, then faded. WARN crossed to the inside early, was unhurried until nearing the drive, advanced and could make little impact. SLURVE forwardly placed along the inside to the second turn, tired. MISSIONS DREAM wide early, moved up down the backstretch, then stopped turning for home.
