Footnotes

KISSY COCO set the pace while under a snug hold, controlled the action while off the rail on the far turn, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch and drew off under urging then was eased up late. MY SISTER CONNIE had a shoe repaired in the paddock, was corrected off the heels of KIT INDY at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled in third, was urged along while two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and got up for the place near the wire. FOREST RAINBOW raced three wide on the first turn, stalked the leader on the outside, went three wide on the far turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole, failed to match strides with the winner and was caught for the place late. MINDOLA settled on the inside, tried to advance inside of KIT INDY midway down the backstretch, didn't have enough room when that rival came in a bit and steadied, moved through inside that foe shortly thereafter, saved ground while under urging on the far turn and failed to threaten. KIT INDY was reserved off the pace, came under urging on the far turn and failed to respond. TURKOBEBE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and faltered.
