MONKEYINTHEMIDDLE went straight to the lead, set the clear pace, opened a commanding advantage on the backstretch, extended the lead even further on the far turn, was asked for more in upper stretch, came under the whip coming to the furlong marker, shortened stride severely while tired late and desperately held under vigorous urging. GEOCACHE raced inside on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, was blocked behind a wall of horses from the three-eighths pole to the quarter-pole, found room and was asked at the top of the stretch, moved out inside the three-sixteenths pole, rallied in the final furlong and closed with a rush late to just miss. BADGER BARRY settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and safely secured the show while no threat to the top two. ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. WING A DING lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns and was no factor. RICHLAND CREEK was reserved off the pace, raced between rivals on the far turn and failed to threaten. DEVIL'S APPRENTICE was in tight nearing the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, settled in the middle of the field, went three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. BONWELL raced three wide on the first turn, followed the clear leader from second, went three wide while between rivals on the far turn and came up empty. ONE MORE KING raced three to four wide on the turns and was outrun.
