MASTEROFHEREVELS wearing a nasal strip, was out sprinted early, rallied four wide around the turn, gained command before the drive and proved best under strong handling. ABOUND forward from the rail, lacked the needed kick. IMMEDIATE ACTION between rivals early, rallied late mid track. UNION MILLS saved ground until the drive, eased out in upper stretch, lacked room, angled in and finished gamely. CLASP saved ground to the drive, angled out and closed a late gap. PERFECT SLEEPER settled early, circled while rallying and hung. GEORGE DOTCOM showed speed for a half and weakened. ST. HADIF saved ground and had no rally. DAYTON'S BLUFF raced close up for a half and gave way. NORTHERN PEARL trailed and was not a factor. BUBBLY FAN was always back. TRACE'S HADIF vied for the lead and then stopped badly.
