KIM'S PRETTY KAREN was well placed just off the pace, raced between rivals while patient on the turn, found room when BETTERTHANFICTION drifted out and was asked at the top of the stretch, made a bid passing the three-sixteenths pole, came in a tad near the furlong marker, inched clear shortly thereafter then held under strong urging. FIVE NATIONS was urged along on the inside, saved ground while behind rivals on the turn, steadied while awaiting room in upper stretch, tried to squeeze through inside of LUCKY SKAT near the furlong marker, bumped with that rival and didn't have enough room then steadied, regained momentum once clear shortly thereafter and closed fast late to just miss in a tough trip. MEG'S EXPECTATIONS was ridden along at the back of the field, raced two then three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch, was put to a drive and finished well for the show. DOUBLE ZADO broke a bit slow, moved up while urged along, raced three wide on the turn, shifted five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. LUCKY SKAT showed good speed and set the pace, vied inside on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, bumped with FIVE NATIONS and steadied near the furlong marker then weakened. BETTERTHANFICTION chased then pressed the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and tired. SULTRY WISPER stalked the leader on the outside, moved up and vied three to four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. TIMELESS MISS settled off the pace, raced four wide into the turn then dropped to one off the rail and failed to respond. Following the race, the stewards' held an inquiry into the stretch run and the rider of FIVE NATIONS lodged an objection against the winner. After the stewards' review, no change was made to the order of finish.
