ROCK HARD well back, circled foes while rallying, exchanged brushes with GIANT'S TOMB down the lane and gained the nod. GIANT'S TOMB reserved off the rail, bid outside for the drive, exchanged brushes with ROCK HARD and missed. CANADIAN WISH inside to the drive, angled out while rallying, came in after and did not have enough late. DEPAUL prompted the pace outside MR. WINTHROP to the drive, got clear and then weakened late. PEGASUS PRANCER raced inside to no avail. MR. WINTHROP set a pressured pace to the drive, then gave way. WHY NOT BE PERFECT forwardly placed inside, angled out in the lane and then faded. ICE CLIMBER forwardly placed to the drive, stopped.
