Footnotes

QUEENIE VIC went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch, chased on the outside, drifted out a bit near the eighth-pole, was straightened by the rider, gained ground on the outside, pulled alongside the runner-up, was carried out by that rival in the final sixteenth and narrowly prevailed. SUNSHINEANDSILENCE went three to four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, made a bid while four wide on the far turn, inched clear in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth, drifted out significantly late and was caught. SILVER AMI went three then two wide on the first turn, became a bit rank late on the first bend, continued a bit rank while hard held early on the backstretch, settled more kindly after that, was asked midway through the far turn, came three wide into the stretch, chased under the whip, moved in some in the final furlong and finished willingly for the show. NECESSARY LUXURY moved up early on the backstretch, contested the pace on the outside, chased in upper stretch and weakened. SILENT LEGACY broke through the gate prior to the start, came away alertly, set the pace on the inside, was joined by NECESSARY LUXURY early on the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, chased in upper stretch and tired. EVEN FOREST was last away, angled in at the rear, saved ground on the first turn, settled at the back, bobbled near the five-sixteenths pole then was eased but walked off.
