FLYERS LEGACY reserved early, saved ground around the turn, angled out four wide in upper stretch, closed determinedly and was clear late. FOUND TREASURE saved ground while out sprinted, eased out in upper stretch and was game for second. TWO ZIP sprinted clear early, responded when collared and gave way grudgingly. RUSH THE RANSOM saved ground and rallied mildly from the rail. GOODAS I. LOOK raced wide. PROMISING WEST forwardly placed, had no response. SEE HERE showed little. PRECIOUS PLUM close up, faded. BANSHEE BRIDE stalked TWO ZIP from early on, bid approaching the drive and flattened out inside the final furlong. BESSIE'S CHIPS raced wide.
