Footnotes

BLUEZY raced two to three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced three wide on the far turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, drifted out inside the furlong marker, was switched to a right-handed whip, gained ground on the outside and got up to win going away. JACK'S SPIRIT went straight to the front, set the clear pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, came under the whip in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. MONKEY HANDS raced off the rail on the first turn, followed the solo leader, chased while off the rail on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while best of the rest. BIGBANDIT dropped to the inside on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was ridden along on the far turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and improved position. INQUISIT raced four wide on the first turn, settled in the front half of the field, advanced inside leaving the backstretch, saved ground while ridden along on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. BRANDONSBABYBLAYRE raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. LANE CHANGER raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and was no factor. RYANIDE raced three then two wide on the first turn, lagged well back in the field, shifted three wide early on the far turn, moved to four wide near the three-eighths pole and showed little. SOUTHERN MALIBU was asked early, raced inside on the first turn, dropped back while urged along on the backstretch and retreated. ANGEL'S SHOW was taken back at the start then eager early, came out entering the first turn, went five wide on that turn, raced near the back, went three to four wide on the far turn and was outrun. NAJEEB T. M. D. was off about two lengths behind the field, raced six wide on the first turn and also showed little.
