SUEDE SHOE raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer near the half-mile pole, went three then four wide on the far turn, brushed with LAVERNE near the three-sixteenths pole, gained under a drive, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled with HERE OUI GO AGAIN in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. HERE OUI GO AGAIN saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, moved closer while off the rail on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch, rallied to the lead near the eighth-pole, battled with the winner in the final furlong and just missed. NECESSARY LUXURY set the pace on the inside, was asked near the quarter-pole, lost the lead near the furlong marker and was outfinished while clear for the show. LAVERNE settled nicely in third position, went three wide on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, brushed with SUEDE SHOE in upper stretch and weakened. BLESSED MOON raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped in near the half-mile pole, was urged along while saving ground on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SOLEIL ROUGE stalked the pace on the outside, vied outside on the far turn, gained a brief lead at the top of the stretch, battled past the three-sixteenths pole then weakened. ELLUSIVE WILDCAT went two then three wide on the first turn, settled towards the back, went three wide early on the far turn, drifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond.
