Footnotes

SIR BOND raced five wide into the first turn then dropped to three wide, settled well off the pace, went three then four wide early on the far turn, advanced five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, swung seven wide into the stretch, stormed to the front near the three-sixteenths pole and drew away while green. LAST GUNFIGHTER broke out and was last way, went three then two wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, advanced on the far turn, squeezed through along the rail near the furlong marker and safely secured the place. BRIGADE went four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn, floated five wide into the stretch, drifted out near the furlong marker and weakened while able to get the show. COLLYMORE PLACE settled off the pace, raced inside on the far turn and lacked the needed response. ROUND MIDNIGHT went three wide on the first turn, raced in the front half of the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and tired. MONEY ONLY bumped lightly with a rival at the start, set the pace through solid fractions, raced inside on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way. MUCHO MACHO UNO saved ground on the first turn, raced towards the front, chased while off the rail on the far turn and came up empty. AT THE PULPIT went three then two wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to respond. HENNY ONE saved ground on the first turn, moved out early on the backstretch, settled towards the back, advanced five then six wide on the far turn, came eight wide into the stretch and also failed to respond. PROPER EMPIRE went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, advanced three then four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch and had nothing left. GLOBAL QUESTION bumped lightly with a rival after the start, was taken up while in tight between rivals early, lagged

well back in the field, went four wide on the far turn and showed little. BRANDO went four then three wide on the first turn, raced near the middle of the field, came up empty on the far turn and retreated.
