Footnotes

MUTASAAWY settled on the inside, was urged along on the far turn, came off the rail at the five-sixteenths, shifted out under a drive in upper stretch, rallied on the inside of CALL ME WEST and closed well to get up at the wire. GENTLEMAN'S HONOR brushed with a rival at the start, raced inside on the first turn, settled in third position, was urged along while in the two path on the far turn, shifted three wide into the stretch, made a bid near the three-sixteenths pole, battled gamely with RUN WITH HONOR, held the lead late but was denied at the wire. RUN WITH HONOR followed the solo leader while off the rail, advanced under urging on the far turn, took the lead at the quarter-pole, battled with GENTLEMAN'S HONOR into the final sixteenth, fought on determinedly but missed while just able to get the show. CALL ME WEST raced inside on the first turn, settled in the middle of the spread out field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside while alongside the winner, closed well into the final sixteenth and finished willingly but just missed the trifecta. FEDERAL AGENT settled well off the pace while in the two path, dropped to the inside midway through the far turn, came back off the rail at the furlong marker and lacked the needed response. THUNDER'S ROLLIN' went to the front, opened up a sizeable advantage while eager and hard to rate, saw his lead diminish on the far turn, lost the advantage at the quarter-pole, dropped back in upper stretch and gave way. MARGIN was last away, raced in the two path on the first turn, lagged well back, raced inside on the far turn and failed to threaten. DEWEY LAKE went three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced three then two wide on the far turn and failed to respond. LUICCI brushed with an opponent at the start, went four wide on the first turn and showed little. (Rail at 18 Feet)
