Footnotes

BAWDENS eased in a bit going to the first turn, settled behind the leaders down the backstretch, split foes before the second turn, angled to the rail, bid inside JOHNNY COME LATELY midway around the turn, gained the edge and proved best under strong handling. SIR JAZZ unhurried early, rallied four wide around the second turn, ranged up outside the winner a furlong out and then could not overtake that one. WAKE FOREST raced inside to nearing the drive, angled out after turning for home and then could make little impact. JOHNNY COME LATELY stalked the leaders three wide early, surged clear midway down the backstretch, responded when collared and then faltered once headed. BEHRENS DESIGN veered out at the break, raced forward off the rail to the second turn and then weakened. CATFISH POINT vied for the early lead and then stopped. BOBBYS HOLIDAY hard pressed while holding the early lead, dropped back approaching the second turn.
