MR. SHORTY set the pace under some pressure, was asked when challenged outside the five-sixteenths pole, responded gamely when put to a strong left-handed whip in upper stretch, inched clear inside the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a right-handed whip coming to the furlong marker, extended the lead shortly thereafter, switched back to a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and proved much the best under vigorous handling. BLACKNGOLDSUPRBOWL tracked the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, was asked in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, made a bid at the top of the stretch, lost touch with the winner inside the three-sixteenths pole and proved no match while clear for the place. BRAXTON COUNTY pressed then chased the pace on the outside, raced three wide on the turn, made a bid near the three-eighths pole, was put to the whip in upper stretch, dropped out nearing the furlong marker and weakened. STRAIGHT SUGAR broke a bit slow, settled near the back of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. J. BURLE was a bit slow into stride, settled near the back while under some urging, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten.
