**Footnotes**

DEPUTY GONE WILD bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the inside entering the first turn, was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, was given a few taps of a down-turned whip near the furlong marker, jumped tracks near the sixteenth-pole and drew off while ridden out. GOLDILICIOUS raced four wide early on the first turn then dropped to one off the rail, was well placed down the backstretch, came under urging while inside early on the far turn, moved off the rail near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and safely secured the place while no match for the winner. THEREISGOLDAHEAD broke out and was last away, was a bit rank while five then four wide on the first turn, raced in the middle of the field while under restraint, was asked while off the rail near the three-eighths pole, moved to three wide near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted five wide at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive shortly thereafter and was best of the rest. WATERTOWN ROAD raced three wide on the first turn, settled just off the pace on the outside, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn, drifted out a bit inside the three-sixteenths pole and came up empty. U KNOW WHAT I LIKE settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, saved ground into the stretch and failed to respond. MADELINEVILLE bumped with a rival at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field and also failed to respond. UPTOWN GLORY broke outward at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, tracked the leader on the outside, chased two then three wide on the far turn and tired. BETH'S ANGEL raced off the rail on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, saved ground on the far turn and showed little.
