Footnotes

DURANGO TANGO bumped with a rival at the start, was well placed just off the pace, chased while off the rail on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip nearing the furlong marker, rallied on the outside, gained ground on the tiring leaders and got up late under continued left hand urging. SURREPTITIOUSLY bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace on the inside, vied along the rail on the turn, dueled with RULE THE SKY in the stretch, had the rider lose his whip outside the sixteenth-pole, held the lead late but was denied. RULE THE SKY disputed the pace on the outside, vied off the rail on the turn, dueled with SURREPTITIOUSLY in the stretch and was outfinished late while clear for the show. BAIL OUT THE CAT settled off the pace, was roused while off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. TALE OF A GOLFER settled off the pace, saved ground while urged along on the turn and also failed to rally. MR. BUBBA CAT was rated on the outside, came under urging while three wide on the turn and failed to respond.
