Footnotes

ROYALTON settled early, ranged up three wide around the second turn, gained the edge in upper stretch and was clear late. VICTORY DAWN close up, bid inside VERMONT'S POCKET down the backstretch, responded when challenged by ROYALTON but was no match late. PORTCULLIS unhurried, saved ground and rallied mildly along the rail. FINAL STRIKE raced inside until the drive, angled out four wide nearing mid stretch and could make little impact. JAVELIN settled early, moved up between foes down the backstretch, rallied nearing the drive and flattened out. CASTNER well back, improved position. SHADY VALLEY prominently placed off the rail, tired. COSSATOT FALLS hopped at the start, got out around the first turn and was outrun. IVERSON restrained off the leaders, gained the lead three wide and then stopped. FASTAWAY forwardly placed, bolted around the second turn. VERMONT'S POCKET broke alertly, crossed to the rail and tired once headed.
