Footnotes

THUNDERING DOWN was hustled from the start and quickly sped clear, was challenged midway through the turn, came under stronger urging at the top of the stretch, shook off BETSY'STHIRDTRICK outside the furlong marker and drew clear under strong urging. AFTER THE FACT lugged in while ridden along on the backstretch, lost position while four wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail, moved out in upper stretch, lugged inward in the final furlong and finished willingly to get the place in a green effort. BETSY'STHIRDTRICK was hard ridden on the outside, advanced five wide leaving the backstretch, made a bid while three wide midway through the turn, battled into upper stretch then tired and was caught for the place at the wire. BRIDLESTONE'S GIRL was hustled from the start then ridden along while off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, continued four wide into the stretch and also finished willingly but just missed the show. ZOO SECRET chased the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn and weakened. NATIVE HEAVEN chased the early pace then dropped back, raced inside on the turn and came up empty. HURRICANE HADLEY settled towards the rear, dropped to the inside near the three-eighths pole, saved ground into the stretch and failed to respond.

HURRICANE SANDY was reluctant to load, raced towards the outside while ridden along, went five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. ALL MOST ENOUGH bumped hard with DIRECT JILL at the start, was ridden along near the back, raced three then four wide on the turn and was no factor. DIRECT JILL bumped hard with ALL MOST ENOUGH at the start, rushed up then chased the leader, raced off the rail on the turn and capitulated. RAINBOWINTHEDARK broke three or four lengths slow, raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and never reached contention.
