Footnotes

AQTAAR went four wide on the first turn, was rated towards the front while on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn, gained the lead under a drive in upper stretch then moved clear, drifted out under a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, was straightened by the rider and proved much the best while under a strong hand ride to the wire. NEV'S CAT was rated while off the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, was blocked behind the leading trio in upper stretch, swerved to the outside for room, came under a drive and safely secured the place. DECLAN set the pace on the inside, vied along the rail on the far turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and tired while able to get the show. WANDERING KITTEN was bumped after the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. MY FRIEND TAG came out at the start, was taken in hand while eager in the early going, went three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace while under restraint, made a bid on the far turn, vied into upper stretch and weakened. BASONE came out at the start then bumped with a rival, saved ground on the first turn, settled in the back half of the field, was urged along while two then three wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. SPLENDIFEROUS bumped with rivals after the start, saved ground on the first turn, was unhurried near the back, went two then three wide on the far turn, swung four wide into the stretch and

was no factor. FATHER'S FUTURE was reserved towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and failed to threaten. TRAGERS TRIGGER went three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced three then four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. LAUGH IT OFF was bumped on both sides at the start then in tight, went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, raced three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the five-sixteenths pole, came six wide into the stretch and never reached contention. (Rail at 15 Feet)
