STAR SHOPPER raced well back in the field, went four then five wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside, closed strongly to get the lead inside the furlong marker then drew away under strong urging. WILDLEE FUNNY disputed the pace on the outside, dueled two to three wide on the turn, led into the final furlong but proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. WHO'S SHINING NOW contested the pace on the inside of WILDLEE FUNNY, dueled with that rival on the turn, vied into the final furlong and weakened while just able to hold the show. SUMMERINTHETETONS was urged along on the outside, chased four then three wide on the turn, pursued WILDLEE FUNNY into the final furlong and tired. TOT SHOP DONNA was urged along while just off the pace, chased while off the rail on the turn and capitulated. DARLIN DARLENE was urged along towards the rear, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. ALWAYS IN TROUBLE broke in and bumped with a rival, was urged along while off the pace, went two then three wide on the turn and also failed to threaten. SMOOTH SALUTE bumped with rivals at the start, was ridden along in the middle of the field, went three to four

wide on the turn and came up empty. MATEYA was ridden along on the outside, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond. FIRE ARMS showed speed then chased the pace, came up empty while inside on the turn and faded. GLORY'S BRESIN BY was a bit reluctant to load, raced well back in the field and was no factor. ABIGAIL GRACE was fractious in the gate, bumped with a rival at the start, was ridden along early then taken in hand midway down the backstretch, shifted out approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, raced off the rail on the turn and retreated.
